Suggestion: * In AE curriculum, the Elective subjects like Introduction to Aircraft and Its Systems and Helicopter Theory should be taught by Airport authority personal and it should be case study base.

*CSE departments were asked to present Learning clusters or Domains in four to five groups.

*Python programming and Mat lab programming can be taught together as scripting language.

*The committee suggested that Linear Algebra should be taught as a core subject.

*Department of Electrical and Electronics Engineering-Inclusion of subjects like Battery and Battery Management System, Super capacitors and Battery, Biomedical Instrumentation as electives.

*Scheme and Syllabus presented by various departments were appreciated, however for some departments minimal changes were suggested for better delivery of content.

*The Scheme and Curriculum of 2017-18 of BE V to VIII semesters of all branches has been discussed, approved and forwarded for GC approval.

*The Scheme and Syllabus of 2018-19 of BE III to VIII semesters of all branches was discussed, the suggestion and modification made by the committee members were to be incorporated and then forward the curriculum for GC approval.
