As a result of the escalation of the corona virus outbreak around the world, we wanted to let you know what your college (Nitte Meenakshi Institute of Technology) is doing.

**LOCK DOWN:** As per directives from official sources, NMIT is under a lock down till end of day 14-April-2020. Stay tuned for any further communications in this regard and do consider only official communications from Principal/HoDs.

Entry and exit of people to our campus has been stopped. Teachers and non-essential non-teaching staff who live outside the campus are not permitted to enter. Students who order on-line are expected to pick up their items from the main gate.

**ACADEMICS:** Department Heads and teachers are providing on-line teaching. Faculty are also providing study material and question banks which we believe will be particularly useful to students who have poor internet connectivity. Other sources for on-line learning are being shared with students so that they may access supplementary learning material.

Year1 ( II Semester) students may access <http://impartus.com> for video recordings of class room training that are available on Impartus -- the Teaching Learning App. The Login ID and Password have been sent to students by email.

Students can login through the above website link or download the Impartus app from Playstore. All the first year subjects are available on-line. We encourage Year1 students to watch these videos of Year1 subjects. If the student has problems logging in, he/she may contact the help line available on the app.

**HOSTELS:** We have very few students in our hostels. Most students who stay in the hostels have left for home. For these students who are on campus, we continue to provide food. We foresee no food problems for several weeks because we are adequately stocked. Furthermore, fresh supplies are available.

The students who continue to stay at our hostels have been informed of essential best practices that will minimize the chances of an outbreak in our campus. We continue to engage a few housekeeping staff who keep our hostels clean.

**PLACEMENT:** The Placement department continues to keep in touch with companies in order to minimize the impact on recruitment. In this context, we encourage your son/daughter to invest special efforts on his/her project so that opportunities for a job or admission stay undiminished.
